Organisational Structure

The overall operational responsibility of the Club's structure is governed by the Board of Management. All bowling related issues and administration rests with the Bowlers Committee. If you ever need help or have any questions, the names of both the Board and committee can be found on the club notice board.

Who to talk to

If you're new to bowls with no existing contacts, your fabulous coach will be your best point of contact. If you're an experienced bowler and new to the club, one of our committee members will be more than happy to help. Also, our club president will provide you with a guided tour to help you become familiarized with the club.

Weekly Games

The Club holds regular games each week, and you are welcome to join on any day. All you need to do is enter your name on the nomination form for the corresponding day/s you would like to play. The forms are located under the shelf in front Selectors Office which is directly opposite the front entrance. The forms are updated each week. Starting time is 1pm (5pm for evenings) and you are required to be at the club 30 minutes before to register and pay your roll up fees of \$5, \$10 or \$12 (\$2 goes towards the raffle prize) depending upon the day. By being there at 30 mins earlier also allows the selectors to fill in for any late withdrawals.
