Instruction for markers

DO: Be neatly attired in Club Uniform. DO: Introduce yourself to both players. DO: Be conversant with the ownership of bowls. DO: Centre the jack, after it has come to rest. DO: If you believe the jack is not at least 21 metres from mat line, CALL THE UMPIRE. DO: Note the mat is correctly aligned, before play starts. DO: Retire to a position 2 metres behind the jack, and 1.5 metres to one side. DO: Not let your shadow fall on bowls or jack, or any rink. Remain motionless, keep eyes on player in possession of DO: Watch for signals, listed for requests, from player in possession of rink. Only give information that is requested. Do not make any suggestions. DO: Answer questions briefly, with yes or no. If question is unclear, ask for clarification, and only from player in possession of rink. Hand indications can be used. DO: Be sure, when asked which bowl is shot, or how many. If not, indicate a measure. Be aware, "Jack High" rarely occurs. "Just Short" or "Just Past" may be used. DO: DO: Be alert to any bowl that could be a toucher. Move up side of rink, after a drive is delivered. Watch Jack. If a toucher, see where bowl stops. DO: Mark all touchers, immediately they come to rest. Do not touch bowl being marked. DO: Remove dead bowls from ditch immediately. For line bowls, or jack, see confirmation from players. If you are in doubt, call the umpire. DO: Stop any bowls from adjoining rinks that could come into your head. Don't lift bowls. DO: Keep clear of head at finished end. The players determine shots, do not make suggestions. DO: Fill in score card immediately score confirmed. Confirm score with players, every end. Place score on the board, every second end. DO: At the end of play, sign the card or cards, after the players have done so. Mark card, or cards, with the time match finished. Then pass cards to Games Controllers. DO: Stand as per instructions. Do not sit on bank, or the seats. If tired, or unwell, call for a replacement. DO: When walking to the other end, walk between centre line, and rink boundary. DO: Remove any chalk left on bowls, which players haven't removed before bowling.
