

## **BOWLS COMMITTEE PRESIDENT'S REPORT – 17 December 2025**

The Bowls Committee for 2026 has been established with all Committee and Coordinator positions being filled.

The role of Catering Coordinator has been established in the Committee which will coordinate non-Bistro catering for bowls events. Jaydene will continue to coordinate with the Bistro for any events they are involved in.

The Volunteers Register is being updated as the information in it is three years old. So far we have just over 40 members that have responded which is just a little bit disappointing given we have over 300 members.

The SLBC 2026 Bowls Calendar Of Events has been finalised and released. Once again everything is very tight, timeframe wise.

The Presentation night has been successfully held, although bowls members participation was quite disappointing.

The Junior Program has wound up for the year and a review with the Coaching Coordinators will be undertaken in January to discuss the 2026 program.

Following a report from the Greenkeeper of damage done to the green by a member dumping bowls, an official supportive letter has been sent to that member recommending actions to be taken in improving their bowls release. If no action is taken, a second more aggressive letter will be sent. If still no action, a third letter will be sent informing them of their suspension of playing bowls at our club.

The Selection Policy For Rep Games has been reviewed and updated and will be utilised for the Taylor and Pumicestone competitions in February.

The last Special Bowls Event of the calendar year was held last Sunday with the successful running of the Club's Christmas Bowls event.
