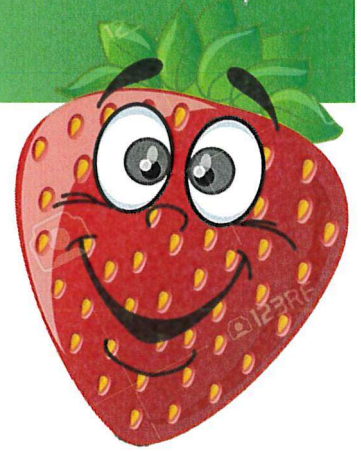

Schedule of Play

An Open Draw will be conducted on the morning of day one 1

Day one - 3 games, each of **16 ends** or the bell

Round 1: **ROLLUP** at 8.45am - Game commences at 9.00am to 11.15am finish

Lunch: 11.15am

Round 2: 12.00pm to 2.15pm - **NO ROLLUPS**

Round 3: 2.30pm to 4.45pm - **NO ROLLUPS**

Day two - 2 games, each of **18 ends** or the bell

Round 4: Game commences at 9.00am to 11.45am finish - **NO ROLLUPS**

Lunch: 12.00 noon

Round 5: 12.45pm to 3.30pm - **NO ROLLUPS**

Presentation of prizes from 4pm

Conditions of Play

Rolling of Jack: If the jack is rolled into the ditch or out-of-bounds, the opposing team can place the jack anywhere on the line and the matt can also be moved.

Dead ends - Jack to be re-spotted on 2 metre mark as close as possible to the "T"

10 ends will constitute a game.

In the event of a forfeit/bye, the opposing team will be awarded 10 points and the average winning points scored in that round including end wins.

Substitutions/Playing positions of players can be changed for each game

Teams must play **ALL ROUNDS** to be eligible for a daily winners prize.

A team **cannot** win more than **one major prize**.

The tournament committee **shall exercise** the power to **alter** these conditions if it be **deemed** necessary, and that decision will be **final**

Scoring

- Teams receive 1 point for each end won in every game.
- No points are awarded if an end is unplayed or tied.
- A game win is 10 points. A draw is 5 points.
- No drawn games - a further end to be played to decide a winner, **or** a decision made by **both** teams to share the points equally (5 points each) is acceptable.
- Overall Results based on: Wins – Ends – Margins – Margin %
